Quality Assurance in the AVEPRO sense aims at creating a culture of quality in the European Ecclesiastical Faculties In particular, it aims at:

- improvement in the Institution's **support environment** to facilitate academic improvement
- ORGANIZATIONAL IMPROVEMENT over time and institutional selfresponsability
- → STRATEGIC PLANNING: where does the Institution want to go and how does it get there
- FITNESS FOR PURPOSE: review in terms of Institution's own particular goals and policies
- → ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE
