  In this respect, the form is used to clarify and verify details of the SER, in
  - particular the assessment form aims at providing the team of experts with a standardised analysis of the SER
- The suggested INDEX FOR THE EXTERNAL EVALUATION REPORT that the Evaluation Commission has to prepare at the end of the Site Visit or, in other terms, at the end of the evaluation exercise




